



## MARITIME SECURITY OFFICER

### Introduction

This model course is intended to provide the knowledge required to enable personnel with designated security duties in connection with a Ship Security Plan (SSP) to enhance ship security in accordance with the requirements of Chapter XI-2 of SOLAS 74 as amended, the ISPS Code, and section A-VI/6-1 of the STCW Code, as amended.

### Objectives

- knowledge of current security threats and patterns;
- recognition and detection of weapons, dangerous substances and devices;
- recognition, on a non-discriminatory basis, of characteristics and behavioral patterns of persons who are likely to threaten security;
- techniques used to circumvent security measures;
- crowd management and control techniques;
- security related communications;
- knowledge of emergency procedures and contingency plans;
- operation of security equipment and systems;
- testing, calibration and at-sea maintenance of security equipment and systems;
- inspection, control, and monitoring techniques; and
- methods of physical searches of persons, personal effects, baggage, cargo, and ship stores.
