



## MARITIME SECURITY OFFICER 1

### **Introduction**

This is a general course offered for individuals who are already in the security industry who require adaption to maritime environment. Basic seamanship, basic navigation skills and ship engineering knowledge are essential for the candidate to be successful. Basic skills of seamanship, swimming and general ship knowledge is important for candidates understanding and an appreciation of a Maritime Security Environment.

### **Objectives**

After completing this course the successful candidate should be able to identify security situations, demonstrate leadership in taking charge of a security team onboard a vessel and advise and guide the ship’s captain, watch keepers and crew on emergency drills, and ship preparations for emergency.

- Basic coastal navigation
- Basic celestial navigation
- Emergencies & Survival at sea
- Firefighting skills
- Report Writing
- Maritime Communication skills
- Weapon handling in Maritime environment

- Navigational aids and tools
- Relevant Maritime Legislations

### **Course Outcomes**

The successful candidate will be able to be officer assisting the Security Team Commander on operational deployment with the capability of taking charge in the absence of the chief officer and is able to lead Security team operations.

### **Teaching and Mode of Delivery**

Lecture, visual aids, and practical exercise methods.

### **Requirements**

- A minimum education of Grade 12 is required for a successful candidate
- Candidates must have a good command of the English language
- Physical Training (PT Exercises) will be conducted daily. Candidates must bring PT wear.
- Pre-requisite of Maritime Security Guard 1

### **Availability**

- Available upon request
- Candidates must provide ID/passport and first day of course.
- A recent medical certificate is also required
- Candidates must provide a recent medical certificate of health and fitness taken no more than 3 months ago
- Minimum of 10 participants per course

### **Assessment**

In addition to a formal written assessment the candidates will be assessed through oral questioning, practical role-play performance and within group interactions.

At the completion of the course a CERTIFICATE IN MARITIME SECURITY OFFICER 1 COURSE will be issued. Qualified as a Maritime Security Officer Grade 1.
