# SECURITY TRAINING FOR SEAFARERS WITH DESIGNATED SECURITY DUTIES

#### Introduction

This training course will offer to officers with designated security duties the training necessary to meet their obligation under the International Ship and Port Facility (ISPS) Code.

#### Aim

To provide necessary training and knowledge for every seafarer who is designated to perform security duties on board including anti-piracy and anti-armed-robbery related activities, according to required standards listed in section A-VI/6-2 of STCW Code in accordance with the 2010 Manila Amendments and ISPS Code. This training is based on IMO model course 3.24.

### **Objectives**

Those who successfully complete the course should be able to demonstrate sufficient knowledge to undertake the duties assigned under the SSP.

#### Outline

The course material has been arranged under the following eleven main headings:

- 1. ISPS Introduction
- 2. Maintain conditions set forth in a ship security plan (SSP)
- 3. Assist in conducting and maintaining ship security assessment
- 4. Proper usage of security equipment and systems
- 5. Threat identification, recognition of security risks and threats
- Under take regular security inspection of the ship
- 7. Emergency preparedness, drills and exercises

## **Certificates**

PMTC will issue certificate to candidates who have demonstrated competence to undertake the tasks as listed in the course areas, outlined above and successfully attended the duration of the course.
