



SECURITY TRAINING FOR SEAFARERS WITH DESIGNATED SECURITY DUTIES

Introduction

This training course will offer to officers with designated security duties the training necessary to meet their obligation under the International Ship and Port Facility (ISPS) Code.

Aim

To provide necessary training and knowledge for every seafarer who is designated to perform security duties on board including anti-piracy and anti-armed-robbery related activities, according to required standards listed in section A-VI/6-2 of STCW Code in accordance with the 2010 Manila Amendments and ISPS Code. This training is based on IMO model course 3.24.

Objectives

Those who successfully complete the course should be able to demonstrate sufficient knowledge to undertake the duties assigned under the SSP.

Outline

The course material has been arranged under the following eleven main headings:

1. ISPS Introduction
2. Maintain conditions set forth in a ship security plan (SSP)
3. Assist in conducting and maintaining ship security assessment
4. Proper usage of security equipment and systems
5. Threat identification, recognition of security risks and threats
6. Under take regular security inspection of the ship
7. Emergency preparedness, drills and exercises

Certificates

PMTC will issue certificate to candidates who have demonstrated competence to undertake the tasks as listed in the course areas, outlined above and successfully attended the duration of the course.

Requirements

Candidate must be at least 18 years of age.
