



MARINE RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

Introduction

This training will provide the participants with the knowledge and understanding for those who would be in the supervisory level, to understand and apply strategic management principles to ensure vessel(s) operate to established quality management principles to comply with statutory requirements. Participants will be enlightened on the basics of marine engines and ship construction and the essentials of condition based maintenance, schedule maintenance and corrective or breakdown maintenance. The training will be further enhanced with understanding and applying cost effective measure and to the operational cost of operating a vessel which covers, procurement cost, inventory management and cost control procedures.

Objectives

The aim of the course is to prepare participants to take on the responsibility of managing the ships operational maintenance and other repairs as situation arises. With a proper attitude that minimizes the risk of unexpected breakdowns and foster good communication, team work, excellent leadership skills and conform to established safe standard operating practices.

- Occupational Health and Safety.
- Pollution prevention measures in regard to Marpol Annexes.
- Monitoring of vessel condition with respect to statutory surveys.
- Procurement and inventory management.
- Analyze and cost control procedures.
- Marine Engineering Technology.
- Quality management system.
- Engine room resource management.

After successful completion of the course the participant will have the understanding and knowledge of marine

resource management which covers the whole vessels operation and the need for good leadership and teamwork to safely and efficiently operate vessels.
