



FIRST AID _ADVANCED

Introduction

This course is designed for seafarers who would apply immediate advanced first aid in the event of an accident or illness onboard a vessel.

This is an advanced first aid training course for seafarers that meet IMO: STCW Regulation VI/4 and STCW Code Section A-VI/4, and requirements under TP 13008 Training Standards for Marine First Aid and Marine Medical Care.

Objectives

To acquire the knowledge and skills that can help to save lives in an emergency situation and handle minor injuries prior the arrival of professional help.

Outline

This course content will cover the following areas.

1. Basic CPR and AED Training
2. Medical Emergency First Aid
 - * Systematic Approach
 - * Crew Members Roles and Responsibilities
 - * Medical emergencies at Sea
 - Drowning
 - Wound bleeding and treatment for shock
 - Head and Cervical spinal injury
 - Heat and cold related factors
 - Fractures
 - Burns and Electrocutation
 - Marine bites and stings

Course Outcomes

The participant who successfully completes the course should be able to do basic CPR and AED and be able to use the systematic approach for medical emergency first aid.

Pre-requisite

The training is preferred for seafarers, who are familiar with ship board emergencies and preferably have completed a basic first aid familiarisation course as per STCW Code, Table A-VI/1-3.

Training Facilities

Classroom with necessary facilities for theory and practical skills training, with sufficient space to be allocated with appropriate presentation equipment.

Assessment and Certificates

Assessment is in the form of skills practice (emergency first aid) and skills testing (CPR and the use of AED).

Upon successful completion of the training session a First Aid Training Certificate will be issued in collaboration with SOS International.

Miscellaneous

Candidates attending this training must be 100% in attendance.

Due to the active nature of the training participants are required to wear suitable clothing and footwear. Casual trousers or jeans are recommended.
