



ABLE SEAFARER

Introduction

The Able Seafarer course is designed to train experienced seafarers to upgrade their level of knowledge and skills. This training will enable experienced seafarers to qualify with the recognized qualification as per the 2010 amendments to the STCW Convention and Code, as per Able Seafarer.

Objectives

On the completion of this course, trainees will meet the STCW mandatory minimum requirements for Able Seafarer, as per the 2010 amendments to the 1978 STCW Convention and Code – STCW Code Table A-II/5.

Outline

The Able Seafarer course is structured to comply with requirements specified in Section A-II/5 and Table A-II/5 of the 2010 Manila amendments to the STCW Code and the training also covers the watch keeping arrangement principals to be observed, as stated in Section A-VIII/2, Part 4-2, 5-2 and 5-4.

The trainee who completes the training program should be competent to perform deck side duties of an Able Seafarer in the following areas:

- Bridge Watch Keeping Duties
- Duties of helmsperson
- Vessel handling
- Cargo handling
- Operation of deck machinery
- Knowledge and use of marine ropes
- Anchoring and mooring operations
- Carrying out maintenance using chairs and stages as well as maintenance on deck related machinery
- Awareness and implementing pollution control measures
- Participate in security related duties

Course Outcomes

After successfully completing this course and passing the prescribed assessments, participants will have the competency, knowledge and understanding to participate in any emergencies on board vessels and have the correct attitude and mind frame to identify potential hazards that may pose a danger to human life, property and environment.

Training Facilities

Ship board training facility.

Certificates

Participants will be issued a certificate of completion on successful completion of the course and having passed all theory and practical assessments. Then the candidate can sit for the AB Seafarers certificate by the Maritime Authority.

Who Should Attend:

- The candidate should be at least 18 years of age
- The candidate should meet the pre-requisite requirements and be medically fit
- Candidates attending this training must be 100% in attendance.
