



FIRST AID_ ELEMENTARY

Introduction

The Elementary First Aid Course covers basic theory and practical sessions. The training will enable the participant to provide assessment of needs of casualties and threats to own safety, appreciation of body structure and functions.

The course is aimed at all seafarers to equip them with the basic knowledge and skills to take immediate action upon encountering an accident or other medical emergency and also to provide a first response, life support and management of casualties and incidents until medical aid arrives.

Objectives

This course provides the learner with the knowledge and skills required to provide primary first aid treatment to the sick and injured whilst at sea.

Outline

After completion of this module the trainee will be able to:

1. Outline the basic concepts underlying the practice of First Aid
2. Describe and demonstrate the priorities of management in First Aid Care dealing with life threatening conditions.
3. Describe the dangers associated with a bleeding wound, and manage blood loss.
4. Describe the dangers of and provide management for, fractures
5. Describe the dangers associated with and the management of burns.
6. explain the spread of infection by means of 'cross infection'
7. Able to correctly demonstrate how to
 - place a patient in the recovery position
 - find a pulse
 - apply EAR
 - apply CPR

Pre-requisite

The candidate should at least be 18 years of age and wishes to have a certificate in Elementary First Aid.

Training Facilities

Classroom must be equipped with required facilities to provide theory and practical exercises.

Certificates

The trainee will receive a certificate of competency in elementary First Aid after successfully completing the two days course.

The Certificate of Competency in Elementary First Aid, is a component of the Basic Sea Safety training that all seafarers need to do as per the 2010 amendments to the 1978 STCW Conventions training structure.

All candidates need to be 100% for present for all training sessions, both theory and practical to pass.
