### Objective

The Main Objective of this program is to give opportunity to the current unlicensed Electricians to enhance their knowledge and skills in standards and regulations and prepare them for the Electrician's License Examination. In addition, raise their level of performance through the acquisition and application of the knowledge and skills involved in the Electrical Industry.
