



MARITIME SECURITY GUARD

Introduction

This is a modeled IMO course tailored for individuals in the security industry in PNG who choose to operate in a maritime industry environment. The course is originally designed for all seafarers without any designated security appointment. General awareness of maritime security threat and emergencies,

Objectives

- the meaning and the consequential requirements of the different security levels;
- knowledge of emergency procedures and contingency plans;
- recognition and detection of weapons, dangerous substances, and devices;
- recognition, on a non-discriminatory basis, of characteristics and behavioral patterns of persons who are likely to threaten security; and
- techniques used to circumvent security measures.

- Security Responsibilities
- Threat Identification, Recognition, Drills and Exercises
- Ship Security Actions
- Emergency Preparedness, Drills and Exercises

Course Outcomes

The successful candidate will be able to participate as part of a Security Team on employable at sea, waterway or in a port facility. The successful candidate is able to recognize threats, and be part of a team in counter operations in maritime environment. This course is a prerequisite for Maritime Security Guard 2.

Teaching and Mode of Delivery

Lecture, visual aids, and practical exercise methods.

Requirements

- A minimum education of Grade 10 is required for a successful candidate.
- Currently employed by a Security Company
- Candidates must have a good command of the English language

- Candidates must provide ID/passport on first day of course.
- Candidates must provide a recent medical certificate of health and fitness taken no more than 3 months ago
- Minimum of 10 participants per course

Assessment

In addition to a formal written assessment the candidates will be assessed through oral questioning, practical role-play performance and within group interactions.

Upon completion of the course a CERTIFICATE IN MARITIME SECURITY GUARD COURSE will be issued. Qualified as a Maritime Security Guard Grade 1.
