MARITIME SECURITY GUARD 1

Introduction

This is a general course offered for individuals in the security industry who require adaption to maritime environment. Basic seamanship, basic navigation skills and ship engineering knowledge are essential for the candidate to be successful. Basic skills of seamanship, swimming and general ship knowledge is important for candidates understanding and appreciation of a Maritime Security Officer.

Objectives

After completing this course the successful candidate should be able to operate as a security guard in a maritime environment. He will be able demonstrate tactical skills in taking in a security team onboard a vessel. He will have sufficient knowledge to identify watch keepers and crew, including ship structure and organization on emergency drills, and ship preparations for emergency.

Syllabus

- Basic Seamanship/general ship knowledge
- Basic marine engineering
- Emergencies & Survival at sea
- Firefighting skills
- Maritime Communications skills
- Rules of Engagement
- Weapon handling
- Navigational aids and tools

Course Outcomes

The successful candidate will be able to be officer assisting the Security Team Commander on operational deployment with the capability of taking charge in the absence of the chief officer. The successful candidate is able to run small team operations.

This course is a prerequisite for Maritime Security Guard 2.

Teaching and Mode of Delivery

Lecture, visual aids, and practical exercise methods.

Requirements

- A minimum education of Grade 10 is required for a successful candidate.
- Candidates must have a good command of the English language
- Physical Training (PT Exercises) will be conducted daily. Candidates must bring PT Wear.

Availability

- Available upon request
- Candidates must provide ID/passport on first day of course.
- Candidates must provide a recent medical certificate of health and fitness taken no more than 3 months ago
- Minimum of 10 participants per course

Assessment

In addition to a formal written assessment the candidates will be assessed through oral questioning, practical role-play performance and within group interactions.

Upon completion of the course a CERTIFICATE IN MARITIME SECURITY GUARD 1 COURSE will be issued. Qualified as a Maritime Security Guard Grade 1
