



## DECK RATING 1

### *Introduction*

The PMTC is endeavored to extend its training by offering Deck Rating Grade 1 course, which complies in principle with the mandatory minimum requirements for certification of ratings forming part of a navigational watch on ships of 500 gross tonnage or more as specified in section A-II/4 of STCW Code including 2010 Manila Amendments.

The training course has been tailored by Pacific Maritime Training College (PMTC) into a series of courses that suit the PNG Shipping Industry.

### *Aim*

Our training course stream combine suitable modules to provide seafarers with a comprehensive series of modules to achieve the Knowledge, Understanding and Proficiency required of a rating forming part of a Navigational Watch for the domestic trade as specified in section A-II/4 and B-II/4 of STCW Code as per the 2010 Manila Amendments.

- GP, or Deck Rating Gr 2, Proficiency Certificate;
- Medical Fitness certificate;
- Must complete Approved sea time;
- Basic Safety Training:
  - *Personal Survival Techniques*
  - *Basic Fire Fighting*
  - *Elementary First Aid;*
  - *Personal Safety and Social Responsibilities*
- Security Awareness Training for All Seafarers

### *Course Assessment And Certification*

After successfully completing the required training and passing all internal assessments, the candidate must pass the written and oral exams conducted in accordance with the NMSA requirements to qualify for their certificate of competency.
