It is responsible for carrying over 90% of world trade and employs millions of people around the globe in various roles, from ship and port management to finance law, insurance, ship broking and ship agency services. The program will provide a thorough knowledge and understanding of shipping management which are vital for the effective operations and uninterrupted flow of an international supply chain. Effective management in the different areas of maritime operations are examined while keeping in line with the rapidly changing shipping field.

Course Outcomes

Certificates

On successful completion of the course:

1. A certificate of completion will be issued to candidates, certifying that the holder has successfully completed the first phase of the course and met the assessment criteria.
2. To be awarded a Diploma in Maritime and Shipping Management, participants must submit all assigned projects and receive a pass mark above 70%, within a period of no more than one year.
